



DEEP DIVER COURSE

This course is designed to be an introduction to deep diving and to help you develop the necessary skills, knowledge and techniques to safely participate in deep diving activities.

The Deep Specialty will extend your max depth to 40 meters (Adv Open Water 30 meters). This is a real advantage if you want to explore some of the world's most spectacular wrecks and dive sites which are located at depths just beyond 30m.

COURSE DESCRIPTION

The Deep Specialty consists of four dives which take place over 2 days. At your Instructor's discretion the deep dive from your Advanced Open Water course can be counted as one of the four dives. Before the dives you will need to read through the Deep Diver Manual, watch the Deep Diver DVD and complete the Knowledge Reviews. Your Instructor will then review the information with you at the dive site prior to your dives. The information covered will include safety concepts, equipment considerations and configuration, emergency decompression, nitrogen narcosis, decompression illness.

DAY ONE

Your first dive will be to a depth of between 20 – 30m. At depth we will compare gauges, and at depth carry out some simple timed tasks to investigate the effects of nitrogen narcosis. You will then make a 5m safety stop on your ascent.

On your second dive you will make your descent using only a visual reference. At depth we will examine the effect of pressure on three pressure-sensitive objects. You will then also navigate there and back to a point of reference. Finally you will 5m safety stop on your ascent.

DAY TWO

You will plan and perform a dive to nearly 40m where we will examine the effect depth has on colour. You will also perform an 8 minute simulated emergency decompression stop at 5m, breathing from an emergency air source.

For your final dive you will plan and execute a fun dive between 18 and 30m where you complete a tour for pleasure and explore the dive site.

PREREQUISITES

- Minimum 15 years of age
- Be certified as a PADI Adventure Diver (or have a qualifying certification from another training organization similar to that of a PADI Advanced Open Water Diver.)
- You should be in relatively good health and fitness, You will need to make sure that you can answer 'no' to all the questions on the medical questionnaire, if not you will need medical clearance from a doctor.
