



## UNDERWATER NAVIGATION SPECIALTY

Did you really make your way back to the starting point on your open water and advanced open water navigation exercises using just your compass? Are you about to embark on your Rescue Diver and are concerned you might not find your 'missing diver'? Are you already a Rescue Diver but found the missing diver search a challenge, particularly if it was in low visibility?

The purpose of the PADI Underwater Navigator Specialty course is to familiarise divers with the skills, knowledge, planning, organisation, procedures, techniques, problems, hazards and enjoyment of underwater navigation.

Underwater navigation is a very important skill to learn and is vital for Rescue Divers, Divemasters and Instructors. Here we'll teach you not only how to do advanced navigation with a compass, but also how to use natural navigation while underwater.

### Pre Requisites

- Minimum age 10
- Open Water diver or have an equivalent certification from another training organisation.
- You should be in relatively good health and fitness, like every other course you will need to make sure that you can answer 'no' to all the questions on the medical questionnaire, if not you will need medical clearance from a doctor.

### Course Details

This course is normally run over 1 day in open water. It can be run in conjunction with other specialties. Therefore sessions can take place at Wraysbury, Vobster or Chepstow.
